## **ORDER**

(Hearing on 12.12.2017)

This case was last heard on 16.11.2017 and the Commission had asked certain information from Executive Engineer, PVVNL in reference to REC Letter dated 15.6.2017 and also to inform the Commission that how the electricity can be provided to this part of Motipur Village where the petitioner wants the electricity connection.

- 2. After the last hearing, the petitioner has submitted a letter dated 05.12.2017 to the Commission in which they have informed that PVVNL has already carried out the survey of the Village and they have submitted a proposal for supply of electricity to this part of Motipur Village at a single point from Badrola, Haryana. PVVNL has also submitted their report to UPPCL vide their letter dated 12.09.2017.
- 3. From the respondent side Sri Lal Singh Rakesh, Executive Engineer, Greater Noida Division is present in the hearing. He suggested that it would be better if the supply to this part of villages is undertaken by NPCL but he confirmed that village electrification of Motipur is sanctioned under DDUGJY Scheme as informed by REC but they do not have any nearby 33KV substation. In case the Commission decides that the

supply is to be done by PVVNL, then PVVNL will have to take the supply from Haryana and lay down the required infrastructure.

- 4. The Commission has heard this matter at length in various hearings and finds that under the "Power for All" Scheme of Government of India, to which the State of Uttar Pradesh is also a signatory, provides for electricity connection to every house hold in the state. For implementation of this scheme necessary funds are being provided by Government of India. Therefore, PVVNL is under an obligation to electrify this part of village also and for that it is their choice to source the electricity from Haryana or from any existing substation of PVVNL in the nearby area.
- 5. The Commission directs PVVNL to carry out the electrification work in the hamlet in which the petitioner's Farm Houses or other residential accommodations are coming up. PVVNL will provide the connection at an appropriate point in the hamlet and the petitioner will bear the cost of laying the internal lines to connect their Farm Houses. The other infrastructure in the hamlet will be created by PVVNL as per the guidelines of Government of India. This entire exercise should be started immediately and the progress of the electrification must be intimated to the Commission after three months.
- 6. With the above directions the petition no.1191/2017 stands disposed of.
